29 July 2020	Combined GRS/HHC meeting to start to establish a PHGL PPG (56 patients attended virtually) Prospectus and Terms of Reference drafted
September 2020	Former GRS PPG stood down
November 2020	Interim PHGL PPG lead resigns PHGL appoints new CEO
January 2021	PHGL ready to relaunch the PHGL PPG
15 February 2021	Invite to patients from GRS and HHC to restart process

There are a number of activities that the PHGL needs patient volunteers to be involved in

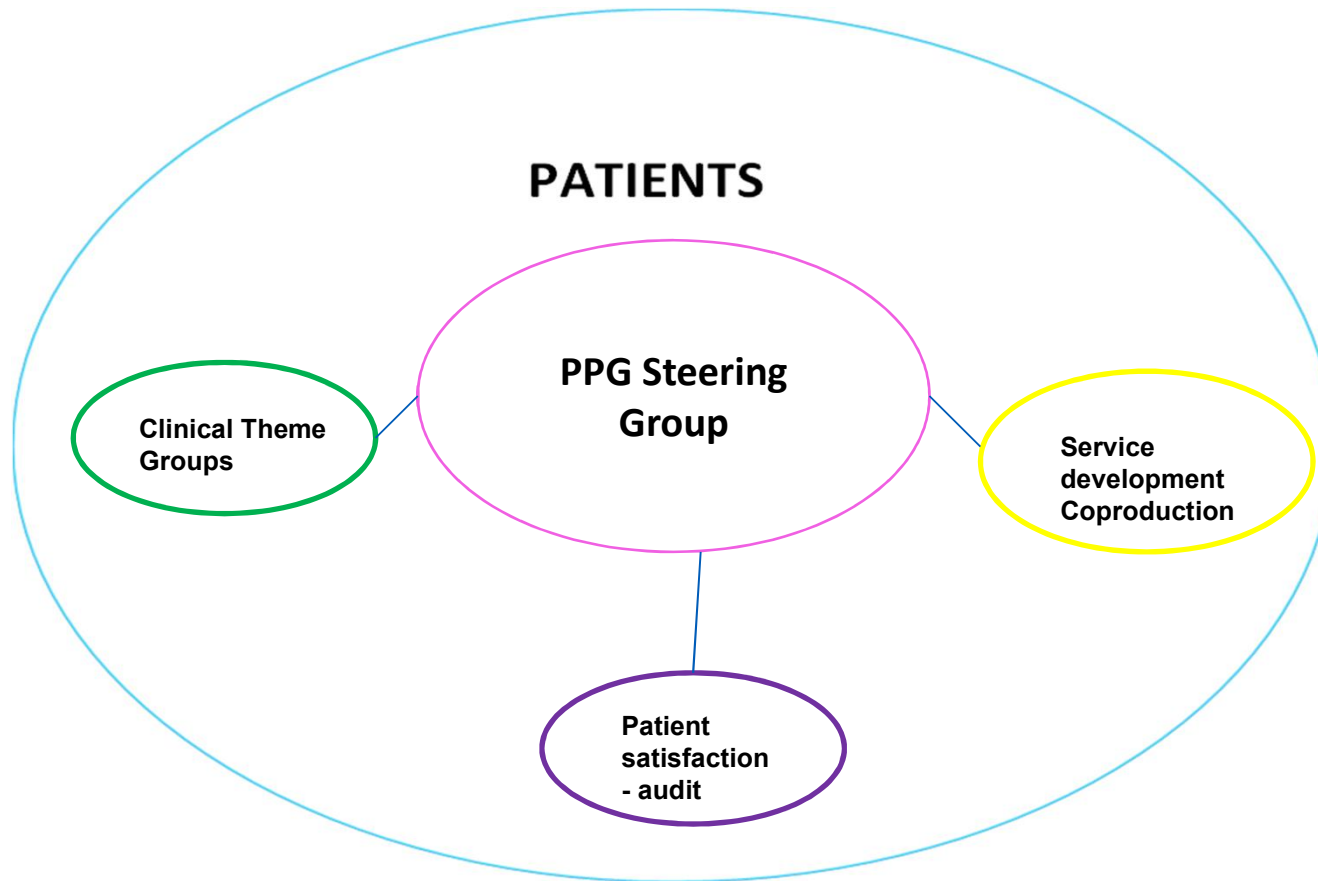
PHGL would like the PPG members to elect a lead and establish a steering group to drive these activities forward

Activities include:

1. Supporting patients with clear information concerning the merging of patient lists (GRS/HHC)
2. Setting up a PPG Advisory Reference Group to lead on the new development planned for the Rugby Ground
 - Exploring access and transport solutions for patients
 - Co-designing the look and feel of the building
 - Exploring opportunities for health and wellbeing initiatives based on the location (as a sporting venue)
 - Exploring opportunities for delivering primary care across 2 sites
 - Supporting GRS patients to relocate to the new development

Early timeline

Feb 2020

- Describe election of Patient Lead and PHGL PPG Steering Group
- Recruit patient volunteers who wish to be involved with activities

March 2020

- Open election of PPG Steering Group
- Set up PPG Advisory Reference Group to support the new development at the Rugby Ground
- Identify PPG support for PHGL merge of patient lists

April to June 2020

- PPG support engagement and consultation processes
- PPG participation in coproduction groups for the new development
- PPG involved in their own priorities



PPG Steering Group - Open Election Process

22 February	<p>Website copy detailing the election process on GRS & HHC websites – electronic form for expressions of interest (EOI) - all patients may apply – paper copies with receptionists in GRS & HHC</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 places for GRS • 2 places for HHC • 1 further place for Patient Lead from either practice – majority will determine
5 March	<p>Closing date EOIs - PHGL publicises EOIs on website – with electronic polling – 5 March until 12 March Paper voting available from receptionists on request</p>
15 March	<p>PHGL PPG Steering Group and new Patient Lead first (virtual) meeting</p>
